

OUR CALLING AND MINISTRY TO SERVE OTHERS

- Ruth 2:9* Let your eyes be on the field that they do reap, and go you after them.
- 2Chr 29:11* My sons, be not now negligent: for the Lord has chosen you to stand before Him, to serve Him, and that you should minister to Him, and burn incense.
- Ps 90:16,17* Let your work appear to your servants, and your glory to their children. Let the beauty of the Lord our God be upon us: and establish the work of our hands upon us; yes, the work of our hands establish it.
- Ps 146:7,8,9* The Lord executes judgment for the oppressed: He gives food to the hungry. The Lord looses the prisoners: the Lord opens the eyes the eyes of the blind: the Lord raises them that are bowed down: the Lord loves the righteous. The Lord preserves the strangers; He relieves the fatherless and widow.
- Pro 5:15,16,17,18* Drink waters out of your own cistern, and running waters out of your own well. Let your fountains be dispersed abroad, and rivers of waters in the streets. Let them be only your own, and not strangers' with you. Let your fountain be blessed: and rejoice with the wife of your youth.
- Ecc 9:7,8* Go your way, eat your bread with joy, and drink your wine with a merry heart; for God now accepts your works. Let your garments be always white; and let your head lack no ointment.
- Is 42:6,7,8,9* I the Lord have called you in righteousness, and will hold your hand, and will keep you, and give you for a covenant of the people, for a light of the Gentiles; to open the blind eyes, to bring out the prisoners from the prison, and them that sit in darkness out of the prison house. I am the Lord: that is My name: and My glory will I not give to another, neither My praise to graven images. Behold the former things are come to pass, and new things do I declare: before they spring forth I tell you of them.
- Is 44:8* Fear not, neither be afraid: have not I told you from that time, and have declared it? You are My witnesses. Is there a God beside Me? Yes, there is no God; I know not any.
- Is 49:2* And He has made my mouth like a sharp sword: in the shadow of His hand has He hidden me, and made me a polished shaft; in His quiver has He hidden me.
- Is 50:4* The Lord God has given me the tongue of the learned, that I should know how to speak a word in season to him that is weary. He wakens morning by morning, He wakens my ear to hear as the learned.
- Is 51:16* And I have put My words in your mouth, and I have covered you in the shadow of My hand, that I may plant the heavens, and lay the foundations of the earth, and say to Zion, You are My people.
- Mat 6:33* But seek you first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added to you.
- Mat 10:6,7,8* But go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel. And as you go, preach, saying, "The kingdom of heaven is at hand. Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely you have received, freely give.
- :19,20* But when they deliver you up, take no thought how or what you shall speak: for it shall be given you in that same hour what you shall speak. For it is not you that speak, but the Spirit of your Father which speaks in you.
- Mat 25:40* And the King shall answer and say to them, Truly I say to you, inasmuch as you have done it to one of the least of these My brethren, you have done it to Me.

- Mat 28:18,19,20* And Jesus came and spoke to them saying, "All power is given to me in heaven and in earth. Go therefore, and teach all nations, baptising them in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit: teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the world. Amen."
- Mk 12:30,31* And you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind, and with all strength: this is the first commandment. And the second is like, namely this, you shall love your neighbour as yourself.
- Lk 19:13* And He called his ten servants, and delivered them ten pounds, and said to them, "Occupy until I come."
- Jn 7:37,38* If any man thirst, let him come to me, and drink. He that believes Me, as the scripture has said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water.
- Jn 15:16* You have not chosen Me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that you should go and bring forth fruit and that your fruit should remain.
- Ac 1:8* But you shall receive power, after the Holy Spirit has come upon you: and you shall be My witnesses to the end of earth.
- Rom 12:3-8* The 7 motivational gifts.
- 1Cor 12:7-11* The 12 gifts of the Spirit.
- 2Cor 3:6* God has made us able ministers of the New Testament: not of the letter but of the Spirit....the Spirit gives life.
- Gal 5:13b* By love serve one another.
- Eph 3:7* The Lord has made me a minister of the gospel, according to the gift of the grace of God given to me by the effectual working of His power.
- Heb 13:15,16* By Him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is the fruit of our lips giving thanks to His Name. But do not forget to do good and fellowship: for with such sacrifices God is well pleased.
- Jam 1:27b* Visit the fatherless and widows in their affliction.
- 1Pet 4:10* As every man has received the gift, even so minister the same one to another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.
